Singapore is famously known our diverse culinary scene with a long list of irresistible iconic food. Below are a few of the many iconic Singapore food that have captured the hearts of many and we look at the origins of these dishes!

Kaya Toast

Kaya toast is considered the national breakfast of Singapore. A decadent kaya toast is simply two slices of golden and crisp toasted bread, with a generous spread of Hainanese kaya and slabs of butter within. Kaya toast is often enjoyed with soft-boiled eggs.

It is believed that Hainanese immigrants who used to work as cooks on British ships, household or hotels, created kaya toast. As British was leaving Singapore in the early 20th century, these cooks saw business opportunities in selling food in coffeeshops. They created kaya and developed kaya toast drawing inspiration from the British breakfast.

Ingredients for making kaya are simple, namely, palm sugar, coconut milk and eggs. Traditionally grilled over a charcoal stove, kaya toast is now toasted using electric toasters. The dish has also evolved into a tea time snack!

Hainanese Chicken Rice

A mouthwatering plate of succulent poached chicken meat, garnished with light soya sauce, sesame oil, cucumber slices and coriander leaves. It is usually eaten with chicken broth infused rice accompanied by garlic chilli sauce with grated ginger.

The dish most likely evolved with local influences, from the salt water boiled Wenchang chicken of Hainan Island to the well-loved Hainanese chicken rice of Singapore! Adopting Cantonese-style cooking, Singapore's Hainanese chicken rice uses younger birds for the tenderness in meat. The poached to perfect doneness chicken is then plunged into icy bath. This action quickly cools the chicken, keeps the meat tender and also results in a jelly-like fat beneath the smooth skin.

Another uniqueness is, the rice used to be served in the form of rice ball, which is a rare sight in Singapore now.

Laksa

Singapore's version of laksa is a bowl of thick rice vermicelli in rich and pleasantly spiced gravy with coconut milk. At the right consistency, the fragrant broth brings out the flavours of the seafood topping like prawns and fishcake.

The origin of laksa is uncertain. Due to the ingredients used, it is likely a creation of the Peranakans. The thick rice vermicelli is used in Chinese dishes while the spice paste is used in Malay dishes. The traditional laksa making method is a lengthy process, requiring hours of stirring and simmering. The coconut milk used is acquired by hand squeezing grated coconut mixed with water. And the spice paste is made from ingredients like laksa leaves, lemongrass, galangal, candlenuts, turmeric, shallots, chillies, garlic and belacan. Nowadays, creative culinary talents in Singapore have come up with a stir-fried version of laksa!

- **Use Sunscreen:** Protect your skin from harmful UVA and UVB rays by applying and reapplying a high SPF broad-spectrum sunscreen, even if you are indoors most of the time.
- Cool Skincare: Store your skincare products in the fridge for a refreshing application.
- Hydrate Your Skin: Regularly moisturise with lightweight, water-based creams or gels to maintain your skin's hydration levels in the heat.



Staying Cool Outdoors

When venturing outdoors, be strategic to stay comfortable and avoid overheating. Here are some tips:

- Stay Hydrated: Always carry an insulated bottle
 with a chilled beverage. Drinking water or
 non-alcoholic drinks replenishes fluids lost through
 sweating and helps regulate your body temperature.
 Avoid alcoholic beverages as they can dehydrate you.
- Time Your Activities: Plan outdoor activities during cooler hours, such as early mornings or late afternoons. Avoid the hottest part of the day, typically between 11am to 3pm.
- Seek Shade: Stay under shaded areas to avoid direct sunlight. For instance when at the beach, look for a spot beneath a tree or umbrella.
- **Carry a Portable Fan**: A portable fan has become a must-have accessory for combating the heat.
- **Take a Swim**: A dip in the pool is an enjoyable way to cool down.
- **Indulge in Cold Treats**: A chilled dessert or an ice-cold drink can provide instant relief from the heat.
- Cold Showers: A quick cold shower after a day in the sun will help lower your body temperature and leave you feeling refreshed.


Did you know?

- A ceiling fan rotating in the anti-clockwise direction creates a breeze by blowing air downwards, making the room feel significantly cooler.
- Placing a bowl of ice or frozen water bottles in front of a fan creates a DIY air cooler that circulates chilled air around your space.
- Carrying an umbrella with a reflective lining can deflect up to 90% of UV rays, keeping you significantly cooler when outdoors.
- Applying cold water or ice packs on pulse points like your wrists, neck, and behind your ears - can help cool your whole body faster because blood vessels are close to the skin at these areas.

Staying Cool at Home

Creating a cool and comfortable indoor environment doesn't have to rely solely on air-conditioning. Consider these tips:

- Enhance Airflow: Position a stand fan near windows to draw in cooler air. Additionally, open doors or windows at opposite ends of your home to encourage cross-ventilation.
- Switch to LED Lighting: LED lights generate less heat compared to traditional light bulbs and help reduce your electricity bill.
- Use Breathable Bedding: Light and airy fabrics such as linen, cotton, Lyocell and Tencel for your bedsheets and pillowcases are perfect for warm nights.
- blackout Curtains: Choose light-coloured blackout curtains or blinds to reflect sunlight and minimise heat absorption. Adding solar films to your windows can further block out sun rays and reduce indoor temperatures by up to 5°C.
- Reduce Humidity: A dehumidifier can make your space feel cooler by lowering the moisture level in the air.
- Keep Windows Open at Night: Let cooler evening air flow into your home by keeping windows and doors open after sunset.



By implementing these tips, you can enjoy a cooler, more comfortable lifestyle without over-relying on air conditioning. Whether indoors or outdoors, staying mindful of your choices can make a big difference in battling Singapore's heat while staying energy-efficient. 


