tossing up in Cantonese, while Yu Sheng (鱼生) means raw fish in Mandarin. The action of tossing up the colourful dish of sliced raw fish with shredded vegetables while saying auspicious phrases, symbolises welcoming greater abundance and prosperity in the New Year!

In the olden days, Yu Sheng was eaten on the seventh day of the first lunar month, also known as everyone's birthday (人日). According to Chinese mythology, Goddess Nuwa created human beings on this day, hence, the celebration of everyone's birthday. Nowadays, Yu Sheng is enjoyed throughout the duration of

celebration meals in Singapore. Lo Hei (捞起) translates to

It is said that in 1930's Cantonese forefathers from China had brought the practice of eating raw fish dish (Yu Sheng) to Singapore. The original version of Yu Sheng had much simpler ingredients like ginger slices, lime juice, spring onion and sesame seeds. The modified version of seven-coloured Yu Sheng (七彩鱼生) was introduced by four chefs in 1960's where fish slices was served with a variety of colourful condiments and sauce. And diners will stand around the table to toss the ingredients.



Today, Yu Sheng is usually served on a big plate at the start of a meal as the appetiser. Diners will stand and gather around the table. This symbolises togetherness and unity. As the Yu Sheng is placed on the table, the ritual starts with auspicious greeting of 恭喜发财! 万事如意! (Congratulations to your good wealth! May all your wishes be fulfilled!). The person leading the diners will proceed to add the ingredients while saying the well-wishes each ingredient represents.


